

TAP @ Dundas COVID Policy



- Students must dance from home if unwell or isolating. Zoom will be set up in the studio so your dancer can still join in the class fun from home and not miss out on a single thing. Meeting ID: 858 5314 9098 Passcode: Dance
- If Government restrictions require us to close our doors, ALL classes will revert to Zoom immediately. Continuing classes on Zoom helps us to stay active and stay connected which is very important through these uncertain times.
- There will be no refunds/reductions on term fees if a student chooses to not participate in Zoom classes if they are isolating or the school is closed. If you are concerned about this you can arrange to pay casual fees instead. Casual fees MUST be paid on the day of attendance either via cash or bank transfer.
- Parents are asked to please drop and go or wait in your car. If for any reason you require to enter the studio, you must check in using our QR code and wear a mask.
- ALL students are required to check in on their own phone or via their parents phone if younger. Once you have scanned the QR code on the ServiceVic app, you can save TAP @ Dundas as a favourite for easier check in next time.
- Students must bring their own named drink bottle to class. Dancing is a physical activity and water is necessary to stay hydrated.
- Students will be directed to sanitise their hands upon entering and exiting the studio.
- All adult students 18+ MUST be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 to participate in classes. We ask that you please show your green tick on the ServiceVic app at your first class so we can mark you off our list. Students aged 5-17 are now eligible for the vaccine, but it is not yet mandatory to have to attend dance classes. If you are between the age of 5-17 and are fully vaccinated, please let us know and we can mark you off the list also.
